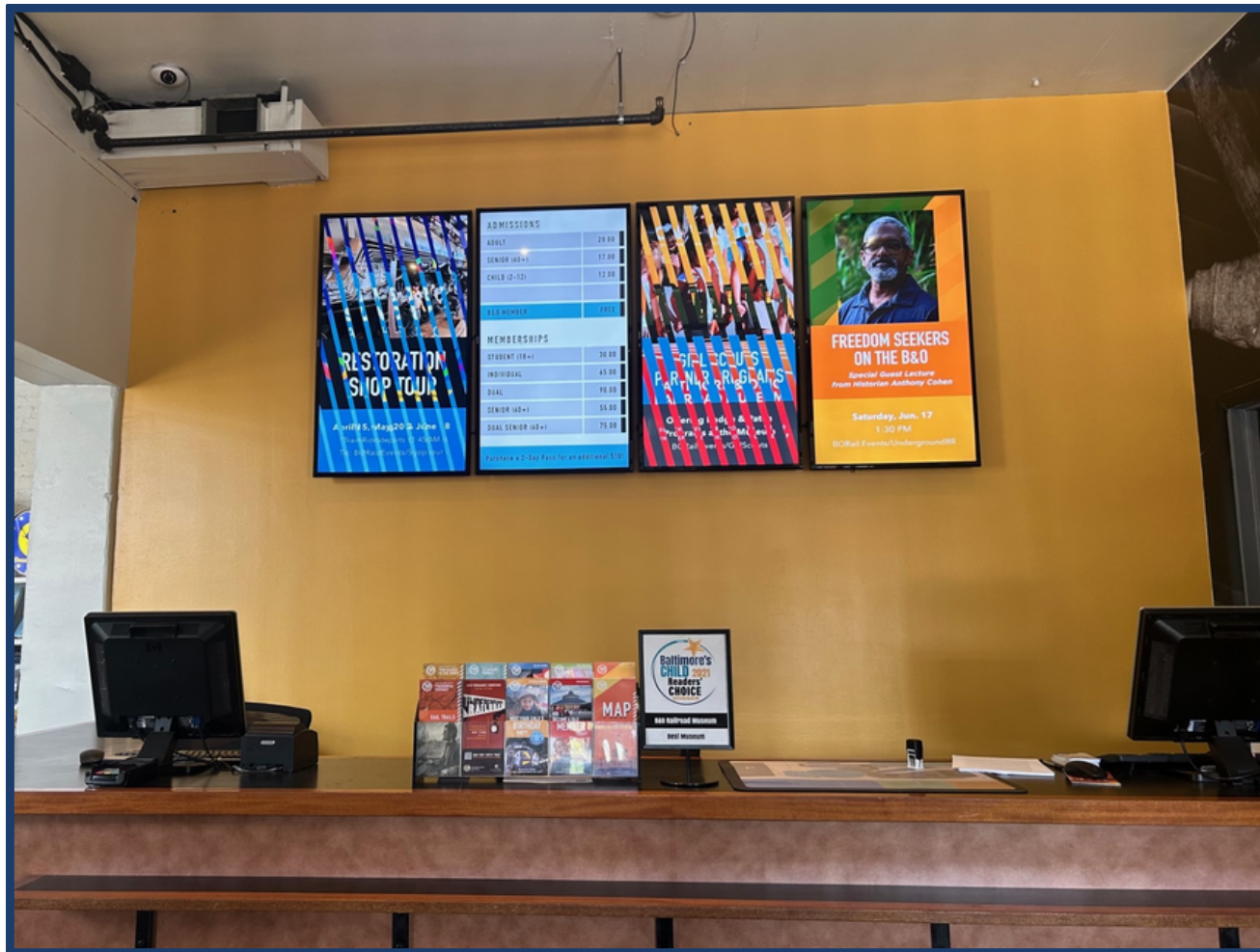




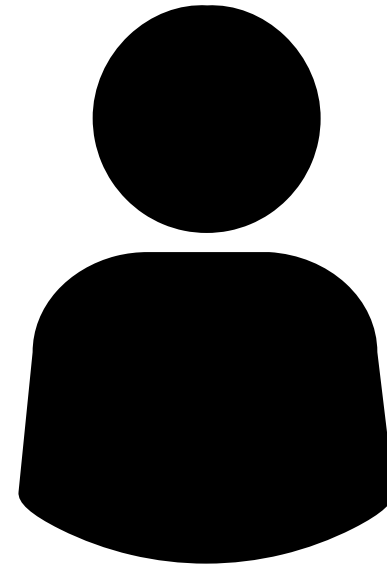
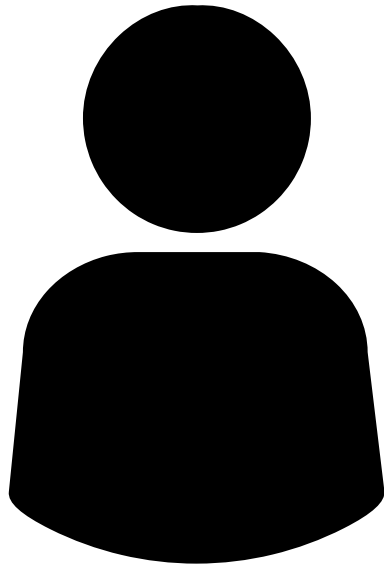
I am going to summer camp at the National Museum of Railroad History and Innovation! The museum has a lot of trains and fun activities.
